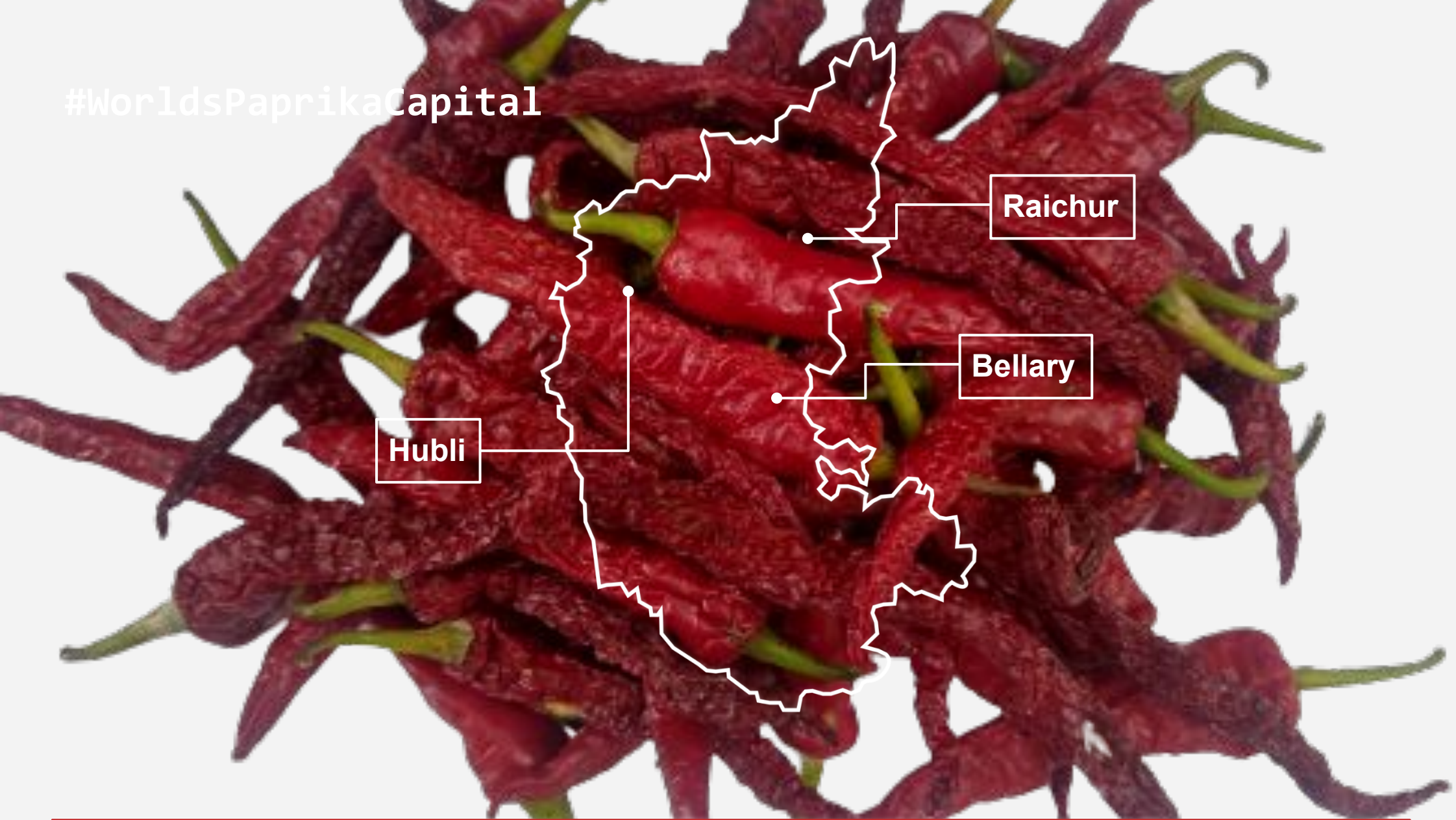

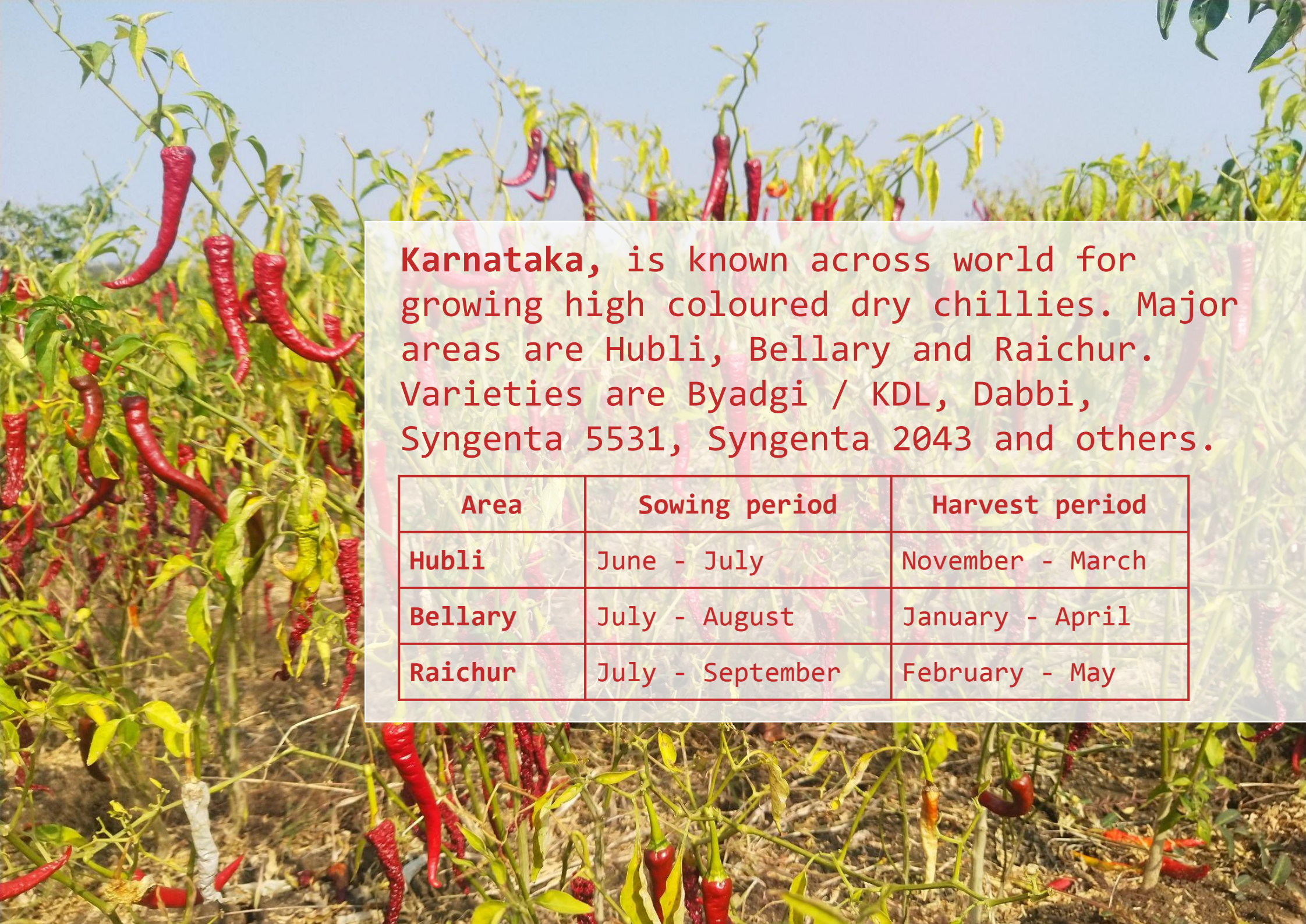

Karnataka Dry Chilli Outlook: March 2023



Karnataka, is known across world for growing high coloured dry chillies. Major areas are Hubli, Bellary and Raichur. Varieties are Byadgi / KDL, Dabbi, Syngenta 5531, Syngenta 2043 and others.

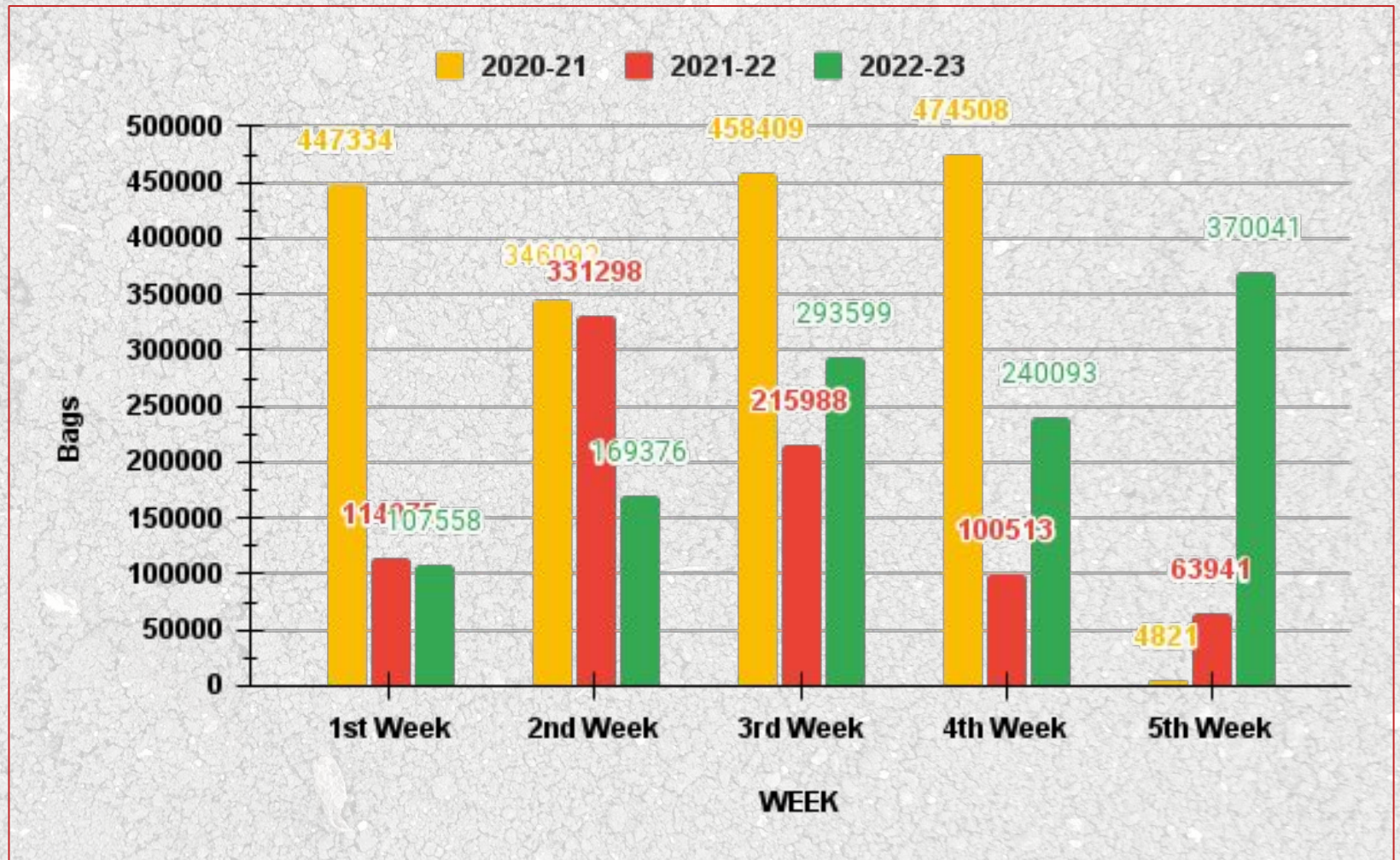
| Area | Sowing period | Harvest period |
|---------|------------------|------------------|
| Hubli | June - July | November - March |
| Bellary | July - August | January - April |
| Raichur | July - September | February - May |

| Area | Rainfall Dates |

| Hubli | 16/3/23 and 17/3/23 |
| Bellary | 19/3/23 |
| Raichur | 17/3/23 and 19/3/23 |

- ❖ There was untimely rainfall in Karnataka in march month.
- ❖ Rainfall was low and it stood just for 2-3 days, so impact of it on crops will be negligible.

March 2023 Summarized

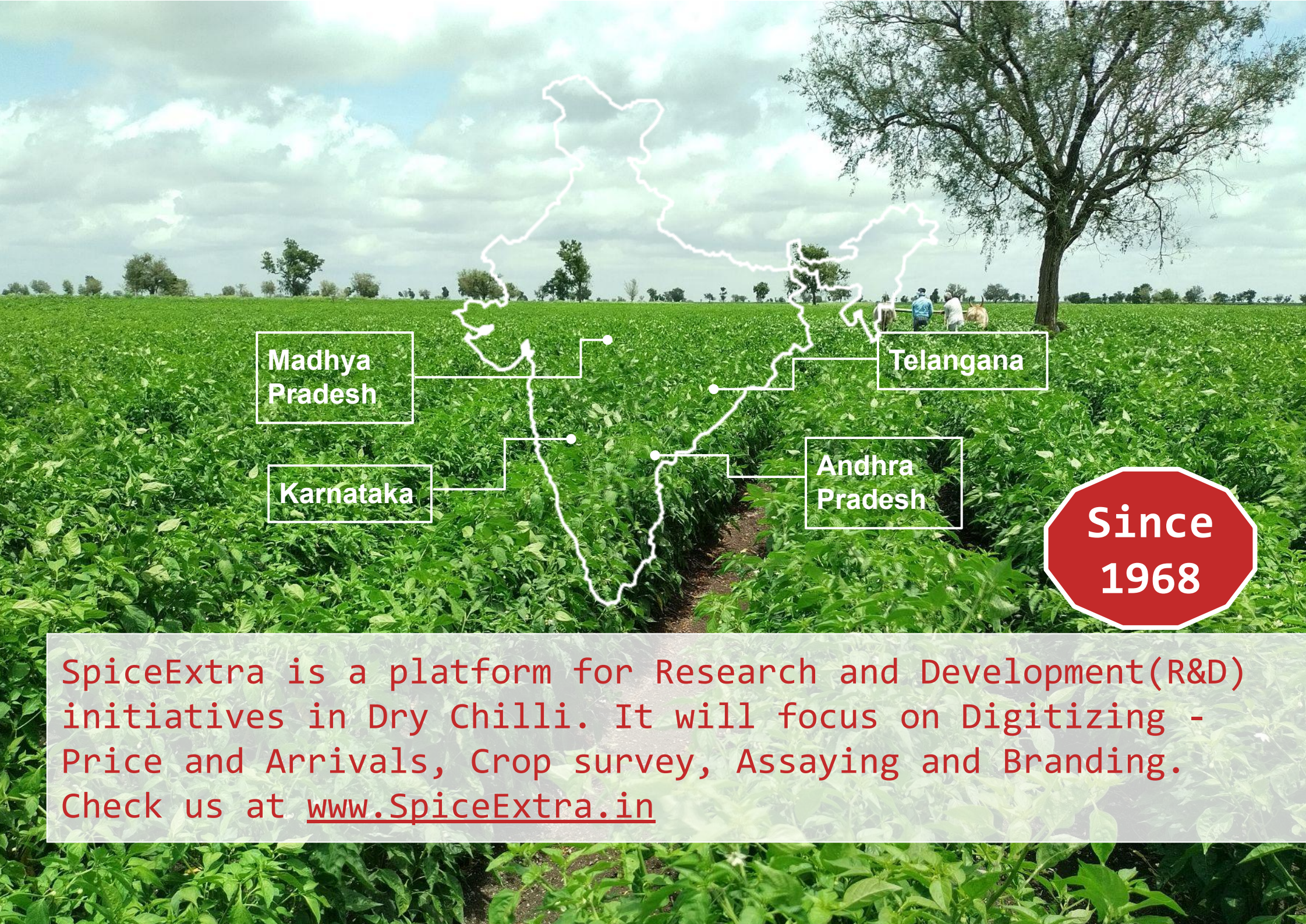
- ❖ Major arrivals were Syngenta 5531, Super-10, Indo-5, Byadgi / KDL, Dabbi and Syngenta 2043.
- ❖ Compared with last year, arrivals are 40 % more, last year we had 10% of arrivals of white colour(very low medium), this year it's just 1-2%.
- ❖ Raichur and Bellary area yield started coming on a higher scale, in these area's Syngenta 5531 is sowed more.
- ❖ Hubli area Local Byadgi/KDL arrivals stopped completely by the 2nd week.
- ❖ March last week Byadgi / KDL price was 63,000 and Syngenta 5531 was 22,000. Prices from 1st week of march to last week stood the same for Syngenta 5531 and for Byadgi / KDL saw a rise of 30%. In mid of march, Syngenta 5531 reached 26,000 rs.
- ❖ March month weather was average for crops, Bellary and Raichur area crops are performing well. Other than 2 days of rainfall and a week of cloudy conditions, climatic conditions were good for crops.
- ❖ Last year there was negligible village buy(Farmgate), but this year its going at a good scale and also farmer's are heading towards cold storage.
